The Organising Authority Dubai International Marine Club (DIMC), The event is to promote modern sailing sport in UAE.

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Basic Racing Rules of sailing will apply.

- **(Rule 10) ON OPPOSITE TACKS**

When are on opposite tacks, a port-tack boat shall keep clear of a starboard-tack boat.

- **(Rule 11) ON THE SAME TACK, OVERLAPPED**

When boats are on the same tack and overlapped, a windward boat shall keep clear of a leeward boat.

- **(Rule 12) ON THE SAME TACK, NOT OVERLAPPED**

When boats are on the same tack and not overlapped, a boat clear astern shall keep clear of a boat clear ahead.

- **(Rule 18) When Rule 18 Applies**

Rule 18 applies between boats when they are required to leave a mark on the same side and at least one of them is in the zone

1.4. The Notice of Race may be changed by an amendment.

1.5. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence



2. Advertising

2.1. The OA may require participants to display event advertising as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions. Any such advertising will be provided by the OA and shall be displayed as described in the Sailing Instructions.

3. Eligibility and Entry

3.1. The event open to boats of the following classes;

Class	Fleet	Max Entries	Eligibility
Optimist Overall	1	Open	under 12
Optimist Junior	1 (Sub Fleet)	Open	under 12
Optimist Girls	1 (Sub Fleet)	Open	under 12
Laser 4.7	2	Open	under 17
Laser 4.7 Girls	2 (Sub Fleet)	Open	under 17

3.2. Proof of age will be required at registration.

3.3. The final entry forms should be received by the OA by 21 February 2017, at 13:00pm

3.4. Late entries may be accepted by the OA subject to availability of boats.

3.5. Competitors shall submit registration form on confirm of attendance.

3.6. There is no entry fee.

4. Format

4.1. The event will consist of a single series of maximum 5 races.



5. Schedule

5.1. Schedule of events;

5.2. The OA and the Race committee reserve the right to modify the above program according to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.

5.3. For each class, there will be a total of 8 races sailed.

5.4. There will be no more than 4 races on each day. The race committee will display flags "AP" over "H" or "A" to signal breaks ashore

5.5. On the racing day, no warning signal will be made after 15:30 local time.

6. Measurement

6.1. Each participant shall produce a valid measurement certificate if requested by the OA.

6.2. Equipment may be scrutinized or measured at any time during the event by the event equipment inspector according to the measurement regulations and approved for compliance with the class rules.

6.3. Boats chartered through the organization may carry national letters or sail numbers in contravention of the class rules. The national letters to be carried shall be those of the member national authority of the skipper.

7. Sailing Instructions

7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.



8. Venue

8.1. The venue and sailing areas of the event are described in Appendix A (TBA)

9. Course

9.1. The race course for all fleets will be a windward/leeward or trapezoid course.

9.2. Diagrams for all areas and courses will be published in the Sailing Instructions.

10. Penalty System

10.1. Decisions of the Local jury will be final.

11. Scoring

11.1. The Scoring will be in accordance with the RRS Appendix A.

11.2. There will be a maximum of 1 discard after 4 races are completed.

12. Support Boats

12.1. If clubs want to bring supporting vessel they may be welcome to do so.

13. Berthing

13.1. Berthing and storage of equipment and boats is available free of charge only during race day.

Teams shall store and/or berth boats and equipment in the areas appointed by the OA.

14. Charter Boats

15. Trophies and Prizes

15.1. Trophies or medals for the regatta will be awarded for the top 3 finishers in each class.

15.2. Prize money shall be awarded as follows;

15.3. A minimum of 10 boats must race to constitute a class eligible for prize money. For the Optimist sub fleets; a minimum of 5 boats must race for the sub—fleet to be eligible for prize money.

15.4. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

15.5. Prize money will be deposited by bank transfer to the account mentioned on the entry form.

15.6. Failure to complete registration by submitting the entry form, bank account details and a valid passport copy, may result in non—payment of prize money.

16. Disclaimer of Liability

16.1. All sailors must be aware that the nature of marine sporting activities may include injury or death. Sailors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. It is the responsibility of the MNA or Team Leader to inform the sailor (and his/her parents) of this.

16.2. All sailors competing in the regattas do so at their own risk and responsibility.

16.3. The Organizing Authority, its supporting partners, clubs and any person involved in the organization of the event will not accept any liability for loss, injury or nuisances to

people or things, both on the water or ashore, occurring as a result of taking part in the event announced in this Notice of Race.

16.4. For all sailors under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian shall sign the disclaimer on the sailor's entry form.

17. Insurance

17.1. All Sailors shall have valid third party liability insurance.

17.2. For any boats that are not chartered through the OA; it is the responsibility of the owner to ensure that the boat is insured with valid third party liability insurance with coverage taking into account the value of the boats.

The original insurance certificate or a copy thereof must be available in case of an incident.
