Racing Rules



Eligibility and Entry

- The event open to boats of the following classes;

Class	Fleet	Max Entries	Eligibility
Optimist Boys	1	Open	Under 14
Optimist Girls	1	Open	Under 14
Laser 4.7 Boys	2	Open	Under 17
Laser 4.7 Girls	2	Open	Under 17
Laser Radial Boys	3	Open	Under 18
Laser Radial Girls	3	Open	Under 18

- Proof of age will be required at registration.
- The final entry forms should be received by the OA by 25th March 2022, at 13:00pm
- Late entries may be accepted by the OA subject to availability of boats.
- Competitors shall submit registration form on confirm of attendance with Passport Copy/Emirates ID.
- There is no entry fee.

Format

- The event will consist of a single series of maximum 5 races.

Schedule

Racing Rules



- The OA and the Race committee reserve the right to modify the above program according to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.
- For each class, there will be a total of 5 races sailed.
- There will be no more than 5 races on race day. The race committee will display flags "AP" over "H" to signal breaks ashore
- On the racing day, no warning signal will be made after 15:30 local time.

Measurement

- Each participant shall produce a valid measurement certificate if requested by the OA.
- Equipment may be scrutinized or measured at any time during the event by the event equipment inspector according to the measurement regulations and approved for compliance with the class rules.
- Boats chartered through the organization may carry national letters or sail numbers in contravention of the class rules. The national letters to be carried may be those of the member national authority of the skipper.

Sailing Instructions

- The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

Venue

- The venue for Heat 1 shall be Dubai Offshore Sailing Club, Jumeirah Beach Road, Umm Suqeim 1, Jumeira 3 - Dubai

Course

- The race course for all fleets will be a windward/leeward or trapezoid course.
- Diagrams for all areas and courses will be discussed in the Sailing Briefing.

Penalty System

- RRS 44.1 and 44.2 shall apply

Scoring

- The Scoring will be in accordance with the RRS Appendix A.
- There will be a maximum of one discard after five races are completed.

Racing Rules



Support Boats

- Support boats must keep a minimum of 50m from competitors racing at all times from the display of the preparatory signal until finish.
- Support boats must obey the instructions of the Race Committee at all times.

Berthing

- Berthing and storage of equipment and boats is available free of charge only during race day.
- Teams shall store and/or berth boats and equipment in the areas appointed by the OA.

Trophies

- Trophies or medals for the regatta will be awarded for the top 3 finishers in each class.

Disclaimer of Liability

- All sailors must be aware that the nature of marine sporting activities may include injury or death. Sailors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.
- All sailors competing in the regattas do so at their own risk and responsibility.
- The Organizing Authority, its supporting partners, clubs and any person involved in the organization of the event will not accept any liability for loss, injury or nuisances to people or things, both on the water or ashore, occurring as a result of taking part in the event announced in this Notice of Race.
- For all sailors under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian shall sign the disclaimer on the sailor's entry form.

Insurance

- All Sailors shall have valid third party liability insurance.
- For any boats that are not chartered through the OA; it is the responsibility of the owner to ensure that the boat is insured with valid third party liability insurance with coverage taking into account the value of the boats.
- The original insurance certificate or a copy thereof must be available in case of an incident.
